Flaris Lar 1 jet is approaching destination

March 17, 2015

The world's smallest airplane FLARIS LAR 1, which was manufactured by a Polish company, will leave the ground for the first time in just a few weeks! Test pilot, instructor and engineer Henryk Szkudlarz will be the first pilot to fly it. Flaris will take off from the airport in Bydgoszcz, where the plane is currently undergoing ground tests.



Podgórzyn near Jelienia Góra is the place where the world's smallest jet was created. This **light weight** aircraft has a drop-shaped **composite structure** and can accommodate several people. It is called FLARIS LAR 1 and can take-off and land even on very small grass airports. The jet was **designed for civilian purposes** but its performance makes it also potentially appropriate for a **variety of military applications**. These include transport and utility aircraft for commanding officers, communications or reconnaissance, as well as for basic and advanced training in modern air navigation. Future plans also include the LAR 1 Bis unmanned version of the plane for reconnaissance purposes. The plane's performance makes it available for use in the HALE category.
